



Fountain of the Sun Association (FOSA) Dog Park Rules

1. All dogs must be registered with FOSA prior to using the Dog Park.
2. All dogs must wear a collar with the FOSA registration tag attached. Registration requires proof of current vaccinations, completion of the registration form and payment of the registration fee.
3. Owners/Handlers and dog(s) use of the Dog Park is at their own risk, including, but not limited to the risk of being bitten or otherwise sustaining injury or illness to the dog(s) under their control.
4. Owners/Handlers are responsible for any injuries or damage caused by the dog(s) under their control in the Dog Park. Owners/Handlers must remain in the Dog Park area at all times their dog is off leash.
5. Owners/Handlers must remove their dog(s) from the Dog Park at the first sign of aggressive behavior. No aggressive dogs are allowed in the Dog Park.
6. All dogs must be leashed before entering and prior to leaving the Dog Park. Dog Owners/Handlers are legally responsible for their dog(s) and any injuries or damages caused by their dog(s) if allowed to run at large per Mesa City Code 6-4-13: - DOGS; LIABILITY.
7. Each Owner/Handler is limited to no more than 2 dogs per visit to the Dog Park.
8. Children under age 8 are not permitted inside the Dog Park. Children age 8 - 16 must be accompanied by an adult FOSA Resident. No one under the age of 17 will be permitted to bring/supervise a dog.
9. Owners/Handlers must clean up after their dog(s) and properly dispose of waste in containers provided.
10. Leave all food and dog treats at home. Bring special toys at your own risk.
11. Dogs under 4 months old, female dogs in heat or dogs with fresh wounds or illness must not use the Dog Park.
12. Any dog biting a person or another dog causing injury will lose Dog Park privileges.
13. Owner(s) may follow the appeals process to regain Dog Park privileges.
14. Complaints may be filed using the FOSA Complaint Form available at the FOSA Administrative Office.
15. Violations will follow established FOSA Compliance procedures. (FOSA Compliance Committee Policies and Procedures; Section E – Enforcement and Fine Policy, Section F - Appeals Process) A copy of the FOSA Compliance Policies and Procedures may be obtained at the FOSA Administrative Office. Violations may result in the suspension of privileges and/or fines assessed to the resident dog Owner(s).
